"A Reunion Awaits Us"

"I am married to you" **Jeremiah 3:14**

What a powerful truth—God sees His chosen ones as united with His very self. There is possibly no more beautiful or intimate word picture in all of scripture than the title Jesus puts on the collection of His redeemed, namely, the Bride of Christ.

Consider the parallels between the marriage union of a man and a woman and the relationship between Jesus and His chosen Bride.

1. As a man pursues and toils to win the affection of his true love, so Christ has pursued His "beloved". The work of winning the affection of His Bride came with Christ's sacrifice on the cross.

2. As a responsible, loving husband daily meets each need of the one he loves, so Christ, the Great Husband, meets each need for His Bride. He is the faithful, loving provider of our "daily bread".

3. There is one important difference, however. It involves the consummation of the marriage relationship. For that spiritual "marriage", the consummation is still before us. Christ still waits for the time when His bride will "be glad and rejoice and give Him glory, for the marriage of the Lamb has come and His wife has made herself ready" **Revelation 19:7**.

In the meantime, the Church has yet to enjoy the fully realized dignity of being the Wife of Christ. Yet there is coming a day when that consummation of the Lover and Beloved will occur.

I have often been asked, what reunions will be like with our loved ones who have preceded us in death—like wives and husbands, mothers and fathers. I can only guess. But I am pretty convinced of this—any reunion with flesh will be supremely overshadowed by our final, complete union with our Groom, the Lord Jesus Himself.
